What do we learn about God in **Exodus 15:22-27** What did He do? How did He respond to the complaints against Him?

3. How would you describe the difference between the priorities of God and those of Israel?
To what degree were they different?

4. How can asking, “**What does God want?**” lead us to a proper response when in a bitter place?

5. What does surrender to God look like in the following situations?
