ASK GOD FOR WISDOM TO APPLY HIS WORD IN OUR DAILY LIVES

What does God want us to desire/value?	What does God want us to know?	What does God want us to do?
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1. **Read Psalm 119:105-112.** How does the Psalmist express his dependency upon the Lord? What kind of commitments does the Psalmist make? How do dependent people keep commitments?
2. **Read Matthew 5:14-16.** What is does it mean to be a dealer in light? What are our responsibilities as dealers in light?
3. **Read Psalm 119:105, 2 Timothy 2:15; Ephesians 5:8-9.** Why is the light vitally important to our daily lives? What all does darkness describe in the Bible? Where do we find God's light and what does it mean to be a child of light? What is our responsibility to the Light? How can we be approved of God?
4. **Read Psalm 119:107-108.** Do we need to pray with David – REVIVE ME, O LORD? Why or why not? According to Isaiah 57:15, who does God revive? If we are going to pray to be revived, what must be done in our lives? How do we respond in the midst of our afflictions? What should be our prayer?
5. **Read Psalm 119:106, 112.** How do those who have been taught by God live? How do faith and obedience relate (Romans 1:5; 16:26)? How do we incline our hearts to be doers of the Word?
6. **Read Psalm 119:109-110.** What risks did David take in order to serve the Lord? Why are we so risk adverse? What does it mean to forget God's laws? Why are we tempted to do so when facing difficulties? How is our culture trying to snare our hearts and turn us away from God? Read Hebrews 10:36-39. What do we need? What is promised?
7. **Read Psalm 119:111; Psalm 43:3-4.** What heritage(s) do we have from the Lord? What has God given us that is forever? How do we know if we value forever more than the temporal? What do we learn about worship and prayer from the Psalmist in 43:3-4?
