Pastor Billy M. Gotcher Galatians 5:22-26 November 3, 2019 Disciple: A devoted follower of Jesus who is eager to learn God's Word and longs to live God's way.

Discipleship: intentionally entering into accountable relationships that are saturated by the Word of God and empowered by the Holy Spirit in order to reproduce Christ-like disciples.

Psalm 119:9–16 How can a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed according to Your word.¹⁰ With my whole heart I have **sought You**; Oh, let me not wander from Your commandments!¹¹ Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You. ¹² Blessed are You, O LORD! Teach me Your statutes. ¹³ With my lips I have declared All the judgments of Your mouth.

Psalm 119:14–16¹⁴ I have rejoiced in the way of Your testimonies, As much as in all riches.¹⁵ I will meditate on Your precepts, And contemplate Your ways. ¹⁶ | will delight myself in Your statutes; I will not forget Your word.

1 Corinthians 11:23–25 ²³For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; ²⁴ and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."²⁵ In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, <u>saying</u>, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."

I Corinthians 11:26–27 ²⁶ For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

²⁷ Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. > 1 Corinthians 11:28-30 ²⁸ But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup.²⁹ For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. ³⁰ For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep.

Galatians 5:22–26 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, selfcontrol. Against such there is no law.²⁴ And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

The Fruit Of A Disciple Is Determined By The Submission Of Our Heart Part Three

Galatians 5:16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

Pastor's Translation Now I keep saying, you must live continually in submission to the Spirit, so that you might never live to satisfy the flesh.

> Warning:

Galatians 5:21 . . . those who practice such things (i.e. the works of the flesh) will not inherit the kingdom of God.

A. Living in submission to the Spirit produces VIRTUOUS FRUIT.

2. Virtues that enable us to be LIGHT in a DARK world.

Galatians 5:22–23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

2. Virtues that enable us to be LIGHT in a DARK world – Longsuffering

I Thessalonians 5:14 Now we exhort you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, comfort the fainthearted, uphold the weak, be patient with all

Romans 2:4 Or do you despise the riches of His goodness (kindness), forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness (kindness) of God leads you to repentance?

Ephesians 2:5-6 even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), ⁶ and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,

Ephesians 2:7 that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

Colossians 3:12 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering.

Ephesians 4:32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you. – which is part of putting on the new man – which is created in the likeness of God!

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Psalm 34:14–15 Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it. ¹⁵ The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their cry. (quoted in 1 Peter 3:11-12).

Ecclesiastes 3:12 I know that nothing is better for them than to rejoice, and to do good in their lives.

Luke 6:35 But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil.

Romans 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Galatians 6:9 And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart

I Timothy 6:18 Let them do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share.

Hebrews 13:16 But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased
