- PSALM 119:49 **REMEMBER** THE WORD TO YOUR SERVANT, UPON WHICH YOU HAVE CAUSED ME TO HOPE.
- PSALM 119:55 **I REMEMBER** YOUR NAME IN THE NIGHT, O LORD, AND I KEEP YOUR LAW

➤ PSALM 25:6–7 **REMEMBER, O LORD, YOUR TENDER MERCIES AND YOUR LOVINGKINDNESSES,** FOR THEY ARE FROM OF OLD. ⁷ **DO NOT REMEMBER THE SINS OF MY YOUTH, NOR MY TRANSGRESSIONS; ACCORDING TO YOUR MERCY REMEMBER ME, FOR YOUR GOODNESS' SAKE, O LORD.**

- PSALM 74:2 **REMEMBER YOUR CONGREGATION,** *WHICH YOU HAVE PURCHASED OF OLD, THE TRIBE OF YOUR INHERITANCE, WHICH YOU HAVE REDEEMED— THIS MOUNT ZION WHERE YOU HAVE DWELT.*
- PSALM 89:47 **REMEMBER HOW SHORT MY TIME IS;** FOR WHAT FUTILITY HAVE YOU CREATED ALL THE CHILDREN OF MEN?

- PSALM 89:50 **REMEMBER**, LORD, THE REPROACH OF YOUR SERVANTS *HOW I BEAR IN MY BOSOM THE REPROACH OF ALL THE MANY PEOPLES.*
- PSALM 106:4 **REMEMBER ME**, O LORD, WITH THE FAVOR *YOU HAVE TOWARD YOUR PEOPLE.* OH, VISIT ME WITH YOUR SALVATION,

Caused To Hope

A. BY REMEMBERING GOD'S PROMISES TO HIS PEOPLE, v.v. 49-51.

- PSALM 119:49–56 **REMEMBER THE WORD TO YOUR SERVANT, UPON WHICH YOU HAVE CAUSED ME TO HOPE.** ⁵⁰ THIS IS **MY COMFORT** IN MY AFFLICTION, FOR **YOUR WORD HAS GIVEN ME LIFE.** ⁵¹ THE PROUD HAVE ME IN **GREAT DERISION**, *YET I DO NOT TURN ASIDE FROM YOUR LAW.*

- 1 TIMOTHY 1:1 PAUL, AN APOSTLE OF JESUS CHRIST, BY THE COMMANDMENT OF GOD **OUR SAVIOR AND THE LORD JESUS CHRIST, OUR HOPE.**

A. BY REMEMBERING GOD'S PROMISES TO HIS PEOPLE, v.v. 49-51.

- TITUS 2:13–14 **LOOKING FOR THE BLESSED HOPE** AND GLORIOUS APPEARING OF **OUR GREAT GOD AND SAVIOR JESUS CHRIST**, ¹⁴ WHO GAVE HIMSELF FOR US, THAT HE MIGHT REDEEM US FROM EVERY LAWLESS DEED AND **PURIFY FOR HIMSELF *His Own Special* PEOPLE**, ZEALOUS FOR GOOD WORKS

1. THE QUALIFICATION FOR EXPERIENCING HOPE, v. 49

- PSALM 119:49 REMEMBER THE WORD TO **YOUR SERVANT**, UPON WHICH YOU HAVE CAUSED ME TO HOPE

A. Caused to Hope By Remembering God's Promises to His People, v.v. 49-51.

1. THE QUALIFICATION FOR EXPERIENCING HOPE, v. 49.

- EPHESIANS 2:12 THAT AT THAT TIME YOU WERE **WITHOUT CHRIST**, BEING ALIENS FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF ISRAEL AND STRANGERS FROM THE COVENANTS OF PROMISE, **HAVING NO HOPE AND WITHOUT GOD IN THE WORLD**

A. Caused to Hope By Remembering God's Promises to His People, v.v. 49-51.

2. OUR NEED FOR HOPE, v.v. 50-51.

- PSALM 119:50-51 THIS IS MY COMFORT IN **MY AFFLICTION**, FOR YOUR WORD HAS GIVEN ME LIFE. ⁵¹ **THE PROUD HAVE ME IN GREAT DERISION**, *YET* I DO NOT TURN ASIDE FROM YOUR LAW.

2. OUR NEED FOR HOPE, v.v. 50-51.

- 2 CORINTHIANS 1:3-4 BLESSED *BE* THE GOD AND FATHER OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, THE FATHER OF MERCIES AND GOD OF ALL COMFORT. ⁴ **WHO COMFORTS US** IN ALL OUR TRIBULATION, THAT **WE MAY BE ABLE TO COMFORT** THOSE WHO ARE IN ANY TROUBLE, WITH **THE COMFORT** WITH WHICH WE OURSELVES ARE **COMFORTED BY GOD**

A. Caused to Hope By Remembering God's Promises to His People, v.v. 49-51.

2. OUR NEED FOR HOPE, v.v. 50-51.

- 1 THESSALONIANS 4:13–14 BUT I DO NOT WANT YOU TO BE IGNORANT, BRETHREN, CONCERNING THOSE WHO HAVE FALLEN ASLEEP, LEST YOU **SORROW AS OTHERS WHO HAVE NO HOPE.** ¹⁴ FOR IF WE BELIEVE THAT JESUS DIED AND ROSE AGAIN, EVEN SO GOD WILL BRING WITH HIM THOSE WHO SLEEP IN JESUS

B. BY REMEMBERING GOD'S JUDGMENTS – WHAT HE HAS DONE (V.V. 52-54)

- PSALM 119:52 I **REMEMBERED YOUR
JUDGMENTS OF OLD**, O LORD, AND HAVE
COMFORTED MYSELF.

**1. HOPE FILLED HEARTS ARE ENRAGED WHEN GOD IS
DISHONORED (v. 53).**

- **PSALM 119:53 INDIGNATION HAS TAKEN HOLD
OF ME** BECAUSE OF THE WICKED, WHO
FORSAKE YOUR LAW

**2. HOPE FILLED HEARTS FIND JOY IN BEING

- **PSALM 119:54 YOUR STATUTES HAVE BEEN
MY SONGS IN THE HOUSE OF MY
PILGRIMAGE (SORJOURNING).**

2. HOPE FILLED HEARTS FIND JOY IN BEING GOD'S PEOPLE (v. 54).

- ROMANS 5:11 AND NOT ONLY *THAT*, BUT **WE ALSO REJOICE IN GOD** THROUGH OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, THROUGH WHOM WE HAVE NOW RECEIVED THE RECONCILIATION.

2. HOPE FILLED HEARTS FIND JOY IN BEING GOD'S PEOPLE (v. 54).

- ROMANS 12:12 **REJOICING IN HOPE**, PATIENT IN TRIBULATION, CONTINUING STEADFASTLY IN PRAYER,
- 1 CORINTHIANS 13:6 LOVE DOES NOT REJOICE IN INIQUITY, BUT **REJOICES IN THE TRUTH.**

- PHILIPPIANS 4:4 **REJOICE IN THE LORD ALWAYS.**
AGAIN I WILL SAY, REJOICE
- 1 THESSALONIANS 5:16–18 **REJOICE ALWAYS,**
¹⁷ PRAY WITHOUT CEASING, ¹⁸ IN EVERYTHING GIVE
THANKS; FOR **THIS IS THE WILL OF GOD** IN CHRIST
JESUS FOR YOU.

- REVELATION 19:6 AND I HEARD, AS IT WERE, **THE VOICE OF A GREAT MULTITUDE**, AS THE SOUND OF MANY WATERS AND AS THE SOUND OF MIGHTY THUNDERINGS, SAYING, **“ALLELUIA! FOR THE LORD GOD OMNIPOTENT REIGNS!”**

- REVELATION 19:7–8 **LET US BE GLAD AND REJOICE
AND GIVE HIM GLORY, FOR THE MARRIAGE OF THE
LAMB HAS COME, AND **HIS WIFE HAS MADE HERSELF
READY.****" ⁸ AND TO HER IT WAS GRANTED TO BE
ARRAYED IN FINE LINEN, CLEAN AND BRIGHT, FOR THE
FINE LINEN IS THE RIGHTEOUS ACTS OF THE SAINTS

- **PSALM 119:55 I REMEMBER YOUR NAME IN THE NIGHT, O LORD, AND I KEEP YOUR LAW.**

C. BY REMEMBERING GOD'S NAME - HE DOES NOT CHANGE (V.V. 55-56)

- PSALM 119:56 **THIS HAS BECOME MINE,** BECAUSE I KEPT YOUR PRECEPTS.
- PSALM 119:56 (ESV) **THIS BLESSING HAS FALLEN TO ME,** THAT I HAVE KEPT YOUR PRECEPTS
