## **FOR CONFERENCING**

1. **Read Mark 3:6-9** Where did Jesus go after being interrogated by the Pharisees? He has withdrawn from crowds previously. Why is that so and for what purposes?
  
2. **Read Mark 3:6-9 and Psalm 2.** Did opposition from the religious leaders effect the size of the multitude gathering to see Jesus? If so, how? What does the Psalm say about human and political rebellion against God? What is God's reaction to human rebellion in verses 4-6? In verses 7-9, who will ultimately rule and reign? What ought to be (and will be) the human reaction and responsibility be to the future rule of The King?
  
3. **Read I Corinthians 1:18-31.** Be prepared to discuss how this passage should encourage us as witnesses for Christ.
  
4. Jesus' popularity had grown far and wide according to verses 7-8. Verses 9 and 10 indicate what drew the people to Jesus. What was that primarily? What was the greater need of the people? What needs should be primarily addressed by the church today?
  
5. **Read Mark 3:13-19.** (If possible, do a brief overview of the 12 disciples on your own before your Life Group Meeting.) What similarities did the men have? What differences? What does this say about how God uses men and women?
  
6. **Read Mark 6:7-13 & I John 1:1-5.** What were the disciples called to do during Jesus' earthly ministry? What are we called to do today and how are we to do it?
