## FOR CONFERENCING

1. Read Hebrews 19:19-25. As we move into chapter 10 of our Hebrews study, the writer now calls for a response. Up until this time there have been warnings. Look for the warnings in chapters $2,4,5, \& 6$. Write down the ones you find.
2. The writer states two responses to what has been presented about Jesus Christ in verses 22 and 26 . What are the two choices?
3. Read verses 22-24. The appeal to make the right response is based on three key features. What are they? (Hint: each one can be identified with one word and one from each of the 3 verses.)
4. According to verses $\mathbf{1 9 - 2 1}$, we can enter into "The Holiest" boldly. What is the holiest? (Hint: think OT priest's entrance -vs- our entrance now under the new covenant.) What does it mean to enter boldly, and why can we do so? (Hebrews 4:1416 will in part help you answer this question.) Look at verse 20. What was the old way? What is the new way? Why is the new way "living," and what and why is the new veil called "His flesh?"
5. Look at verse 22. How must we draw near? What is our evil conscience referring to and what does it mean that our bodies are "washed with pure water?"
6. In verse 23 , what is "the confession of our hope?"
7. According to verses $\mathbf{2 4} \mathbf{- 2 5}$, what will those who respond in faith and hope do?
8. For what reasons is "the assembling of ourselves together" commanded? In context, who do you think are the ones that were forsaking the assembly? (Hint: refer to \#1)
