TEXT: JOHN 4

I. IF YOU KNEW THE GIFT OF GOD.

Why did Jesus have to go through Samaria?

Why does John tell us about Jesus being weary from the travel? What is John teaching us about Jesus?

A. The Gift Of God Is LIVING Water That Satisfies Forever (4:7-14).

Jeremiah 2:5, 13 and 17:13. What did Israel reject?

Isaiah 55:1 – What is the invitation?

What did Jesus mean when he said that those who drink living water will never be thirsty again?

B. The Gift Of God Is Not For Temporal Comforts Or Pleasures (4:15).

What did the women want from Jesus? How does so much of modern Christianity reduce the gospel to that kind of promise?

C. The Gift Of God Brings SALVATION To All Who Repent And Believe (4:16-26).

What did the woman have to see before she was ready to receive living water?

What does it mean to worship in spirit and truth?

D. The Gift Of God Received Transforms Sinners Into Witnesses Who Share The Gift With Others Passionately And Purposefully (4:27-30).

To whom did the woman go and tell about Jesus? Was she well thought of by the people in the town? What is Jesus driving home?

E. The Gift Of God Commands Its Recipients To Labor Expectantly In God's Harvest Fields (4:31-38).

What were the disciples preoccupied with?

What did Jesus want them to see and understand?

What is our mission?

F. The Gift Of God Is Receiving Jesus As Lord And SAVIOR (4:39-42).

2. **Read John 20:31** – What does it mean to have “Life in His name?” How can a name save?

4. How can we encourage one another in sharing the Gospel purposefully?
5. What was Jesus referring to when he said – “My food is to do the will of him who sent me and accomplish his work?”
6. How do we embrace this same mind-set/attitude/approach found in our Lord Jesus?
7. How do we examine our passions or what reveals our passions?
