## SCRIPTURE READING - JOHN 13:1-17

<sup>1</sup> Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

<sup>2</sup> And supper being ended, the devil having already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray Him, <sup>3</sup> Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God, <sup>4</sup> rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself. <sup>5</sup> After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. <sup>6</sup> Then He came to Simon Peter. And Peter said to Him, "Lord, are You washing my feet?"

<sup>7</sup> Jesus answered and said to him, "What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this."

<sup>8</sup> Peter said to Him, "You shall never wash my feet!"

Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me."

<sup>9</sup> Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head!"

<sup>12</sup> So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you? <sup>13</sup> You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. <sup>14</sup> If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. <sup>15</sup> For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you. <sup>16</sup> Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him. <sup>17</sup> If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.

## FOR LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION

1. **Read Mark 14:12-20.** What did the disciples participate in, and what meal were they going to prepare? **Read I Corinthians 5:7.** Who/What did Paul say Jesus was? Why did Jesus observe the Passover?
2. Why did Jesus keep the place (the “Upper Room”) secret from the disciples?  
**Read Mark 14:17-20.** What is the subject matter of this section? **Read Psalm 41:9.** What is prophesied in this passage? **Read John 13:21-30.** What were the disciples perplexed about? How did Jesus reveal His betrayer? What is it in verse 27 that reveals the great cosmic battle between God and Satan?
3. **Read Mark 14:17-26.** According to verse 24, Jesus instituted a new covenant. What transition did Jesus make here (what would be the old observance and what was to be the new? **Read Luke 22:19-20.** What is the purpose of this new observance (The Lord’s Supper)?

4. **Read Mark 14:20-21 & James 1:13-17.** What do we learn about the will of God here? What harmony and yet tension exists between God's sovereignty and man's choice? Was Judas absolved from blame because God's plan included Judas? Did Judas have every opportunity to choose Jesus rather than reject Him?
5. God used Judas's own sinful choice to bring about His own plan. What does the fact that this is difficult to understand tell us about our Great God?
6. Using the section titles in your Bible for John 13-17, What other things occurred during this meeting/supper in the Upper Room?


