A Christian Life Is A Continual Walk In Christ

Colossians 2:6

As you therefore have **received Christ Jesus the
(as) Lord, so walk in Him.**

Colossians 3:1-4

If then you were raised with Christ, **seek those things which are above**, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. ² **Set your mind on things above**, not on things on the earth. ³ For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ *who is our* life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

**A. In Order To For Us To WALK In CHRIST We Must Have
DIED To Sin And Been RAISED In New Life.**

**B. In Order For Us To Walk In CHRIST We Must Be
Passionate About The Things That Matter Most To
JESUS.**

**C. In Order For Us To Walk In Christ We Must Believe His
Promises And Anticipate Their Fulfillment.**

Before I Received New Life From Jesus I Was :

- **An enemy of God**
- **A stranger to God's family**
- **A slave to sin**
- **A son of disobedience**

Now In Christ I Am:

- **A child of God**
- **Now His adopted child**
- **A slave to righteousness**
- **Holy and beloved**

Before I Received New Life From Jesus I Was :

- Without hope in this world
- Hostile to God
- Living for earthly pleasures
- Destined for eternal wrath

Now In Christ I Am:

- The assurance of eternal life
- Peace with God and submitted to Him
- Living for things above - to please God
- Awaiting pleasures forevermore

When our minds are set on things above, our lives will not be dominated by temporal things!

Colossians 3:5-11

⁵ Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.

⁶ Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience,

⁷ in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them.

⁸ But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth.

Colossians 3:9-11

⁹ Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, ¹⁰ and have put on the new *man* who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him, ¹¹ where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave *nor* free, but Christ *is* all and in all!

A. We Must Put Off The Sin That Destroys Our Private Lives.

- Colossians 3:5 **Therefore** put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.

Matthew 5:29-30

If your right eye causes you to sin, **pluck it out** and cast *it* from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell. ³⁰ And if your right hand causes you to sin, **cut it off** and cast *it* from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell.

1 Corinthians 6:18

Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins **against his own body**.

Hebrews 13:4

Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled;
but **fornicators and adulterers God will judge**

Exodus 20:17

“You shall **not covet** your neighbor’s house; you shall **not covet** your neighbor’s wife, nor his male servant, nor his female servant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor **anything that is your neighbor’s**.

Luke 12:15

And He said to them, “Take heed and **beware of covetousness**, for one’s **life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses**.

Hebrews 13:5

Let your **conduct be without covetousness; be content** with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "*I will never leave you nor forsake you...*"

2 Corinthians 4:16–17

Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though **our outward man is perishing**, yet the inward *man* is being renewed day by day. ¹⁷ For **our light affliction**, which is but for a moment, **is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory.**

B. We Must Put Off The Sin That Derails Our Daily Lives.

- Colossians 3:8 But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth.

2 Corinthians 4:16–17

Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though **our outward man is perishing**, yet the inward *man* is being renewed day by day. ¹⁷ For **our light affliction**, which is but for a moment, **is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory,**

James 3:8-10

But no man can tame **the tongue**. *It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.* ⁹ **With it** we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God. ¹⁰ **Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so.**

C. We Must Put Off The Sin That Dismantles Our Church Lives.

- Colossians 3:9a **Do not lie to one another, . . .**
- Ephesians 4:25 Therefore, **putting away lying,** “Let each one of you **speaking truth with his neighbor,**” for we are **members of one another**

D. The Motivation Given For Putting Off The Old Life.

- Colossians 3:6–7 Because of these things **the wrath of God is coming** upon the sons of disobedience, ⁷ in which you yourselves **once walked** when you lived in them. . .

E. The Reason We Will Put Off The Old Life.

- Colossians 3:9b–11 . . . since **you have put off** the old man with his deeds, ¹⁰ and **have put on** the new *man* who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him, ¹¹ where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave *nor* free, **but Christ is all and in all.**
